

Chubu Electric Power's Overseas Consulting Project

1. Objective of overseas consulting

The overseas consulting project is an effort to contribute toward the development and expansion of electricity businesses in foreign countries, with an emphasis on Asian and African developing countries, by drawing on the knowledge, experience, and technology in the electric business that Chubu Electric Power has fostered thus far. Along with securing a certain amount of revenue, the policy of this effort is to focus on items that are expected to result in a synergy between Japanese and international energy businesses, such as maintaining and passing on technological expertise, making international contributions, or strengthening ties with fuel suppliers.

2. Overseas consulting results

Chubu Electric Power has been rolling out overseas consulting projects since fiscal 1996. Results amount to 164 cases (37 countries) including this project.
